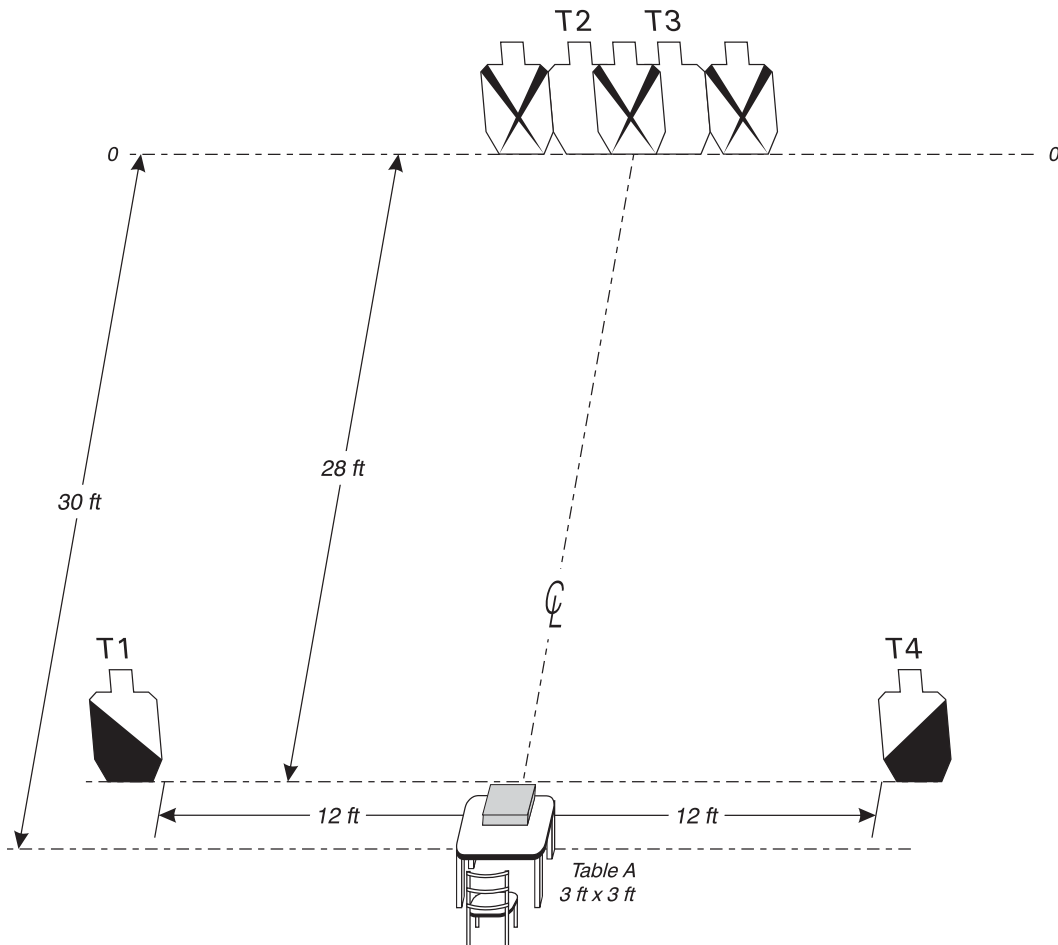
START POSITION: Sitting in chair with both knees under table and back against chair. Both arms are extended straight above shoulders with elbows locked. Loaded gun is in cigar box, lying flat and unsupported as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, retrieve gun from box and engage T1-T4 as they become visible.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 8 rounds, 40 points
TARGETS: 4 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



SETUP NOTES: Set all targets to 4 feet high at shoulders. Set no-shoot between T2 and T3 on left and right edge of A zone, respective. No-shoots at outer edges of T2 and T3 are butted against outer edges of targets. Table is 3 feet by 3 feet. "Cigar box" is 18-



inches by 12-inches by 12 inches high, hinged on back. Top is 20-inches deep by 12-inches wide with a 2-inch overhang at front. Back edge of box is on the back edge of the table and centered left to right. No propping of gun is allowed.
