Administrative / Finances

- Incorporated as 501© non-profit
- 2011 revenues of about \$30,000 (boe calculation – Jon can correct)
 - \$ 3000 club revenue
 - \$ 6000 2011 state match (net – about broke even)
 - \$26,000 2012 area 1 fees
- Donations: many hours, about \$5,000 equipment/targets, \$1000 in ammo/other
- Fund Raisers: \$2,600 Utah state match raffle

Facilities

- Went from 7 bays to 15 + gully run
- Big new parking lot
- Complete 8 stage steel challenge setup (MGM Targets)
- 10 iPod touch scoring devices
- Polish Plate Rack
- MGM Plate Rack
- 90+ walls
- 100+ tires
- Electrical power approved last week – work starts shortly

Club Shoots

- Club match participation rising steadily – largest 36, average mid 20's.
- Volunteer support – approximately 50 different people have contributed substantially at events.
- Now have 5 to 7 juniors regularly participating (and a new one started last night)
- Defensive Matches had good turnout and strong interest.
- Friday Night New Competitor Classes averaging 4 to 8 new competitors.
- Friday Night Practices averaging 6 to 10 participants
- More, and increasing, Vegas participation.
